Its membership includes university and industrial researchers, among whom are astronomers, anthropologists, archaeologists, biologists, chemists, computer scientists, economists, geologists, information specialists, librarians, physicists, psychologists, social scientists and statisticians.

The Society organises meetings, some by itself and some jointly with societies representing application areas for classification.
